

Fire Recovery Metal Recycling



During this time of loss and destruction of property, Methow Recycles stands with all who have experienced losses resulting from the fires and other disasters.

Please see the attached document from the Okanogan County Health Department regarding safe handling of fire debris. Please wear a dust mask religiously when working on your site.

The following information is intended to help with options for dealing with the metal remaining from the fire. I am available to visit any property to provide guidance on cleanup as needed.

All burned metal can be recycled, the question is, what is the best fit for you?

- Small metals may be brought directly to Methow Recycles for no charge and deposited in our big metals bin. Please check in with a staff member first.
- For larger quantities of metal we suggest working with one of the local contractors below to load and deliver your metal to Cascade Concrete. The value of the metal is very low right now, but we have teamed up again up with Cascade Concrete and local contractors to provide property owners an opportunity to indicate how they would like the proceeds from their metal directed.
 - You can receive payment for the metal, or
 - You can direct the proceeds to Methow Recycles to support recycling programs and services.
- Cascade Concrete will request your name, mailing address, and instructions for whether a check should be sent to you or to Methow Recycles.

Following are some Methow Valley businesses we have talked with who are familiar with this program and available to assist with cleanup of your property and hauling of debris. We are happy to add others to this list, and encourage you to ask whoever you're working with to honor this program.

Please make sure your delivery operator knows how you would like the value of your metal directed.
